WHAT IS IN THIS APPLICATION?

For Bermuda and zoysia grass: Granular fertilizer specifically designed for warm season turf and containing substantial amounts of nitrogen and potassium. We also spot sprayed weeds if present. **For shade grass:** Granular fertilizer at a lighter rate designed for fescue and spot spraying for weeds if necessary.

If no rain within 24-48 hours, please water in this application for best results.



WHY IS THERE FERTILIZER ON MY CONCRETE?

In order to provide the best coverage possible, we use a “broadcast” type spreader. This results in some scattering of fertilizer on driveways, walkways and patios. We take all steps possible to minimize the amount of material on your concrete and assure you it will not damage your concrete.

WHAT IF IT RAINS?

Rain will water in the fertilizer for you. If you have weeds present in your lawn, we ask that you give the spot-spraying 7-10 days to show results. If you still see a problem, call us for a free service call.



HOW MUCH SHOULD I WATER?

Drought stress can result if your lawn doesn't receive enough water. Usually, 1 to 2 inches of water per week will keep your lawn healthy. To see if your lawn is receiving enough water, push a 6-inch screwdriver into the ground. If you can push it in easily, your lawn is receiving enough water. If not, you need to water. Heavy watering encourages deep root growth – daily watering encourages a shallow root system. Water in the mornings; evening watering can cause fungus problems.



TIME TO PLAN FALL FESCUE SEEDING!!!

All fescue grass areas must be overseeded each fall, ideally between mid-to-late September through October, to keep it thick and healthy. **Give us a call for a FREE estimate**, or visit our website to read how to do it yourself. Click on SERVICES and then FALL SEEDING.

GRASSY WEEDS

We have seen an abundance of nutsedge and dallisgrass (which is always a problem, since it's the same type of grass as Bermuda). **If grassy weeds were present in your lawn today, we treated them and ask that you refrain from mowing or watering for 24-48 hours to give the material a chance to work.** More frequent mowing promotes outward growth versus upward growth, which in turn thickens the lawn to help control weeds, especially these problem grasses.

NOTE: If your lawn appears drought-stressed, we will not spot spray grassy weeds in order to avoid damage to the lawn in its present condition.

MAY - AUGUST

SEPTEMBER - APRIL

WARM-SEASON GRASSES

Improved bermuda (<i>Midiron, Tifway, Sunturf, etc.</i>)	.5" - .75"	1" - 1.25"
Common Bermuda (<i>Arizona common, Cheyenne, U-3, etc.</i>)	1" - 2"	1.5" - 2"
Zoysia	.5"-1.5"	1" - 2"



COOL SEASON GRASSES

Tall fescue	3"	2.5"

Round 1: January - March

Round 4: July - August

Round 2: March - May

Round 5: August - October

Round 3: May - June

Round 6: October - December
