Today Your Lawn Received its SPRING APPLICATION - ROUND 2



WHAT IS IN THIS APPLICATION?

For bermuda grass: A post emergent application to clean up any broadleaf weeds.

For fescue: The second of two pre-emergent applications for crabgrass control, a pre and post-emergent for broadleaf weed control.



WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS APPLICATION?

This application is a post emergent application for bremuda to clean up any broadleaf weeds left behind and a pre-emergent and post emergent for fescue grass.



HOW DO I KNOW IT'S WORKING?

The broadleaf weeds (like dandelions) will twist or curl, or simply not grow anymore. Browning occurs only at higher temperatures. The weeds remain in the lawn until you mow.



DO I HAVE TO WATER THIS APPLICATION?

Ideally, all our applications should be watered in. However, if you are unable to water, the application will still be effective. Natural precipitation and dew will do the job for you. If you can water, and if you have a broadleaf weed problem, (dandelions, henbit, etc.) try to wait 24 hours before watering. The application should be watered in (either by you or by rainfall) before mowing.



WHAT IF IT RAINS?

Rain right after an application simply waters it in for you. The only thing rain may affect is dandelion control. If you have no broadleaf weeds like dandelions or henbit in your lawn, it should be fine. If you do have dandelions, give the application 10 days to see if the dandelions stop growing. If they don't, simply call us and we'll treat them again.



IS IT OKAY TO LET MY DOG OUT AFTER THE LAWN HAS **BEEN SPRAYED?**

The material in this application has a yellow tint to it, which will not wash off. The yellow color is photo-degradable, which means that sunlight breaks it down. It is advisable to let the application dry before letting your pet out or walking through the lawn. This could take 15 to 45 minutes depending on temperatures and wind.

SHOULD I SEED MY LAWN IN THE SPRING? WARNING: Any seed put down in the spring will hamper and delay us from applying your pre-emergent weed control, which would hamper seed germination.

TIME TO SCALP YOUR BERMUDA OR ZOYSIA LAWN!

When all chance of frost has past, put your mower on its lowest setting,

mow your lawn, and bag the clippings. If your lawn is high, it might be

easier to do this in 2 mowings. This removes the dead grass that has provided insulation all winter and allows the sun to warm the ground,



WHY AREN'T THOSE GRASSY WEEDS DYING?

Grassy weeds take a special material that requires temperatures consistently 80 degrees and above for it to work. If you have weeds that require such treatment, your lawn tech will have already put in a service call to treat it at the required time. Grassy weeds may require repeated treatments which may cause temporary yellowing to your bermuda.
